<sup>13</sup>And you also were included in Christ when you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation. Having believed, you were marked in him with a seal, the promised Holy Spirit,

<sup>14</sup>who is a deposit guaranteeing our inheritance until the redemption of those who are God's possession—to the praise of his glory.

<sup>22</sup>And God placed all things under his feet and appointed him to be head over everything for the church,

<sup>23</sup>which is his body, the fullness of him who fills everything in every way.
