Jesus Makes Resources Ample ... to Me

Jesus saw the physical, emotional, and spiritual needs of His friends and knew the solution was a time of quiet rest and reflection. And He knows the solution is the same for you and me today. So He invites us, as He did His disciples, “Come with Me by yourself to a quiet place and get some rest.”

It was Passover time, it was a national holiday, it was springtime, and it must have seemed the perfect day to join Jesus for a picnic in the hills.

I wonder how the disciples felt as they looked up and saw the trickle of people coming around the end of the lake. I wonder how they felt when they saw the trickle grow into a river that grew into a flood of five thousand men, not counting women and children. Jesus gave up His time to Himself. He gave up His “holiday.” He gave up His “family” time in order to meet the needs of the crowd. He knew that meeting the needs of others invariably requires some personal sacrifice.

Let nothing be wasted."</p> <p>13 So they gathered them and filled twelve baskets with the pieces of the five barley loaves left over by those who had eaten.</p> <p>14 After the people saw the miraculous sign that Jesus did, they began to say, "Surely this is the Prophet who is to come into the world."</p>
