


JESUS IN ME Prayer Group

Welcome to my home. If I had the opportunity I would have you sit down here with me, have a glass of iced tea on this hot summer day and I would just say thank you for being willing to commit yourself to the prayer team for the launch of Jesus In Me. But since we can't do that, because I've been told almost 4,000 of you have signed up for this prayer team, then I've opted to do Facebook Live to just say thank you from the bottom of my heart for the commitment you've made to pray through JESUS IN ME

There are two reasons that I feel like it's very important, for this book, as it's a book on the Holy Spirit, that I wanted to ask you to be a part of the prayer team. One is because I think very few people within the church, and those who call themselves Christians, know about the Holy Spirit. And when I was born and raised you know I was born and raised in a wonderful Christian home that was committed. They loved Jesus, served Jesus, obeyed Jesus but I cannot remember being taught about the Holy Spirit. And so, I wonder if some of you are like that or if you know people like that. I felt God put on my heart to write this book just my experience of the Holy Spirit so that I could lead others into a discovery of who He is. Because I think sometimes we treat Him as an optional extra in the Christian life. And He's not. He's a divine necessity. And when you discover who He is it can revolutionize the vibrancy of your faith and your walk with the Lord. And that's one reason I want you to pray this book through.

The other reason is that I believe we're living at the end of the end. I believe we're at the very end of the last days and any day now the sky is going to unfold. We're going to hear the trumpet blow. Jesus will descend with a mighty shout and we're going to be caught up in the air to be with Jesus forever. So, think about it. Every single person living on planet earth, indwelt by the Holy Spirit, is going to be taken up to Heaven. And so, there will be a moment, an hour, a day, a week, a month when there's not one single person on planet Earth indwelt by the Holy Spirit. So, He will be, in effect and in a practical way, withdrawn from the planet. And yet the Bible teaches, and I believe, that after the rapture after we're caught up in the air to be with Jesus there will be multitudes of people who will remember what we said, what we warned them about, what we tried to encourage them to do. They're going to place their faith in Jesus as Savior and Lord, and I want them to know that He has not abandoned them. That even at the beginning during and at the end of the Tribulation if they come to the Cross by faith, confess their sin, ask Jesus to forgive them come into their hearts, He will come in in the person of the Holy Spirit. They will have as much of the Holy Spirit as you and I have today as Jesus has.

So, I want the book to get out there right now for people before the Rapture because I believe they need to know who the Holy Spirit is. He will enable us to live not just somehow but triumphantly as we live in this wicked godless world. And I want the book out there so that when we're caught up to be with Jesus we leave these books behind and somebody who doesn't know Him or has just put their faith in Him because of our testimony, pick up the book and they read about the Holy Spirit and they discover they've not been abandoned that Jesus loves them and He comes to live in them in the person of the Holy Spirit. So, for those reasons we need to pray. We need to pray through this book.

Thank you for your commitment to pray. Thank you for praying through the promotion, the marketing, the launch of the book, and for me with all the issues that I'm facing that I wouldn't let down one single thing. That I would take every opportunity to do what I can to tell people about Jesus. Not only who lives in heaven and is soon to come back but about Jesus who's come to live inside of me and inside of you when we place our faith in Him. He comes in in the person of the Holy Spirit. So, thank you for being part of the prayer team. And I have a verse for you and it's from Philippians chapter one very familiar one verse three. I thank my God every time I remember you in all my prayers for all of you I always pray with joy because of your partnership in the Gospel. So, thank you for partnering with me. And just I want to take this opportunity also to pray for you.

So, would you pray with me for a moment. So, Father we bow before You and we thank You collectively for who You are. We worship You as the God of creation. We worship You as the God of Abraham Isaac and Jacob the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ who loved us so much He sent Jesus to be our Savior. And when Jesus died on the Cross and rose from the grave and ascended to Heaven, You loved us so much that you didn't leave us like orphans, but You sent down the Holy Spirit to live within us as a constant companion.

So, I thank You for those who are part of our team that they would shoulder the burden and responsibility and the privilege of praying this book through, so it has the greatest possible impact for the Kingdom. And who knows Lord who knows, but that this book will be used of You and even if it's a small way the spark a Great Awakening in Your church before that the trumpet sounds. And before we're caught up in there to meet You. So, Lord we want to be used in every sense of the word through this book and through our lives for Your glory and Your glory alone and we ask these things. I ask your blessing on the prayer team. Bless them Lord, give them insight into how to pray. Encourage them through answers to prayer. And one day when we look back we'll see what You've done that You've put your glory into these earthen vessels and the glory is all Yours. But Lord I'm so grateful for those that You've called to come alongside me. So, bless them. Bless me. Bless this book. Bless our team we pray, and we ask these things in Jesus name and for His glory. Amen.

Sneak Peek #2 | JESUS IN ME | Chapter 15 He Guides Us

HE GUIDES US



To avoid an undirected or misdirected life, leadership institutes and career seminars explain that we need to determine what our purpose is and set goals to accomplish that purpose. Then the priorities we establish are the steps we use to achieve the goals and ultimately fulfill the purpose. Applying this as followers of Jesus Christ, we need to determine our lives' overall purpose, set clearly defined goals that will help us accomplish it, then establish priorities that will enable us to achieve the goals we have set.

We need personal, consistent guidance to keep us focused.

When I was a girl growing up in the mountains, early summer was heralded by the appearance of the indigo bunting, a small cobalt-blue bird with black wings. He would perch on top of the maple tree just outside the rail fence that bordered our front lawn. The unmistakable sound of his lilting song would echo across Little Piney Cove. When I heard it, I would run for my father's binoculars, which he kept in a large brown leather bag in his study. I would take the binoculars out of the bag very carefully, go to the front porch, press the eyepieces against my face, then aim in the direction of the bird's song. But everything was blurred...mountains, trees, rail fence, and grass. So I would turn the little ring between the eyepieces, and as I did, everything would come into sharp focus. There he would be, swaying on top of the maple tree, his beak lifted toward the sky, warbling his heart out.

In a similar way, as we choose to fix our eyes on Jesus, pursue righteousness, live by the truth, and fulfill God's purpose for our lives, the Holy Spirit will guide us, sharpening our focus in the midst of life's distractions and confusion.

If you have made this choice, on what have you focused your entire life? If you were honest, would you say your focus is multifaceted? A little blurred by multiple responsibilities and demands? Is your life's overall purpose to be good? To be holy as He is holy? To be filled with the Holy Spirit? To lead others to faith in Jesus Christ? To maintain your faith through the trials of life? To learn to pray powerfully? To make it into Heaven with an abundance of rewards to lay at His feet? While those can be terrific goals, none of them is sufficient as an overall purpose worth living for. It may be time to ask the Holy Spirit to turn the "ring" and sharpen your focus.

Before I was baptized at the age of nine in Montreat Presbyterian Church, I had to memorize the Westminster Shorter Catechism. I didn't realize until years later that the Holy Spirit would use it to guide me to my life's purpose, but He did. He brought the purpose into focus in the only question and answer that I can actually remember: "What is the chief end of man? Man's chief end is to glorify God, and to enjoy him forever."^[1] I didn't grasp the importance of that pithy statement at the time, but now I understand that it pinpoints our purpose—our "chief end"—as followers of Jesus: It's to glorify God. Pure and simple. In all we do. In all we say. In who we are.

And that overall purpose brings everything in life into sharp focus. It's actually the same purpose for which Jesus lived and died.

If we want to experience the fullness of the Holy Spirit's transforming power, then we must first be willing to throw open the door of every area of our lives and invite Him to fill us with Himself.



Another Counselor July 31 | JOY OF MY HEART



I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Counselor to be with you forever - the Spirit of truth.
John 14:16-17, NIV

Jesus described the Holy Spirit as "Another." The Greek word actually means "another who is exactly the same." So although the Holy Spirit is a distinct person, He is exactly the same as Jesus, but without the physical body. He has been described as Jesus without skin. Or, like an FBI agent, He is Jesus undercover.

We know that Jesus is in heaven. As the first martyr, Stephen, was being stoned to death, he looked up and saw heaven open and Jesus standing at God's right hand, preparing to welcome him home! (Acts 7:56)

But that doesn't mean Jesus has left us to stumble through the darkness of the future on our own. He promised His disciples that when He went to heaven, He would ask His Father to send down to earth "Another." One Who would have His same mind, will, emotions, and intellect. Jesus called Him the Counselor (John 14:16), because He is readily available to give us wisdom for our decisions, direction for our future, insight into our problems, and management for our responsibilities.
