<p>Exodus 17:10-14</p> <p>10. So Joshua fought the Amalekites as Moses had ordered, and Moses, Aaron and Hur went to the top of the hill.</p> <p>11. As long as Moses held up his hands, the Israelites were winning, but whenever he lowered his hands, the Amalekites were winning.</p> <p>12. When Moses' hands grew tired, they took a stone and put it under him and he sat on it.
