II. IN PRIVATE

- How did Phillip start a Bible conversation with the Ethiopian? V.30
- What questions could you use to start a Bible conversation with a friend, co-worker, student, classmate, vendor or family member? Write them out.
- What portion of Scripture did the Ethiopian not understand? Vs.32-34
- Are you afraid to start a Bible conversation for fear you won’t have answers to questions? What can you do to increase your Bible knowledge?
